Conductor of current. Connector of components. The bus bar is used in many electrical applications where its large surface area helps to reduce power loss. Like most bus bars, June's Part of the Month is made out of copper. Starting as a 3' x 8' sheet, blanks are first sheared down to 36" x 19.2", a more manageable size for our turret punch. Once punched, the bus bars are deburred in our grinding room and then move on to the inspection room for final inspection.
