Once Upon A Time At Compucraft

This month we are featuring an aluminum weldment that takes a long journey through our shop. The back half of this weldment is formed sheet metal, as seen in the first image. Next we CNC machine the front bezel and handles which then get dip brazed and mig welded, respectively, as seen in the second image. In the third image we can see welds have been ground flush where applicable, a hinge has been plug welded, and the part has been yellow chromated and had hardware installed. Finally the part gets painted white, silkscreened, and has a gasket installed on the front bezel. From simple brackets to complex weldments, Compucraft has the expertise to get your parts done right with quality that is second to none.
