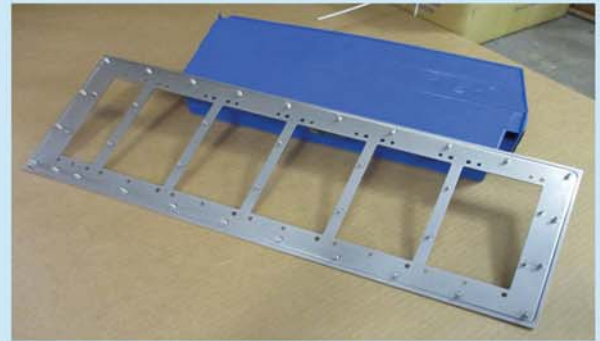

Happy Holidays from CompuCraft

December's Featured Part is a laser cut and machined stainless steel faceplate. After laser cutting the part is checked for flatness, as the amount of material removed from the windows in the part can sometimes relief stresses inherent in the sheet stock. Once the parts have met the flatness requirements they travel to our CNC Machine shop to have a groove cut around the perimeter to allow for the installation of a gasket. Finally panel fasteners are installed and the part is ready to ship to our customer.
