April Showers Bring May Flowers

This month we are featuring a machined item. We have previously featured parts made from steel, stainless steel, aluminum, copper, and titanium, but our current Part of the Month is the first bronze part that we have featured. Starting out as a 1/4" thick bronze sheet, the blanks are rough cut with a water jet. Next they are loaded into one of our five 3-axis vertical machining centers where they are machined to the proper thickness and flatness tolerance. The perimeter is cut to size, and tapped holes are added for helicoil inserts. The final step is to inspect the part with our CMM before shipping the part to our satisfied customer.
