A Hopper for Hoops Month

While you are busy filling out your March Madness bracket, here at CompuCraft we are busy making brackets to weld to the outside of the hopper that is our Featured Part this month. The hopper itself is rolled from 11G stainless steel which is then welded along the seams to create the offset cone that you see here. Meanwhile, 1" thick flanges are machined for the bottom and outrigger ports. There are also formed mounting brackets, laser cut flanges, and other fittings. Everything comes together in the welding department, with fixtures and locating tabs utilized to hold the required tolerances. After removing the weld burn, the part is then ready to ship.
