Problem:

Removing one from eleven makes it ten and removing one from nine makes it ten. Is it even possible?

Yes it is possible in Roman Numerals. In Roman Numerals,

9 = IX

10 = X

11 = XI

Thus by removing one from 9, you are getting 10 and by removing one from 11, you are getting 10 again.
